



Step 1.

ATTACH LEGS TO CHAIR - 1. Attach the front legs (B) to the club chair (A) using washers (D), bolts (E), and wrench (F). **2.** Attach the back legs (C) to the club chair (A) by repeating the same process.



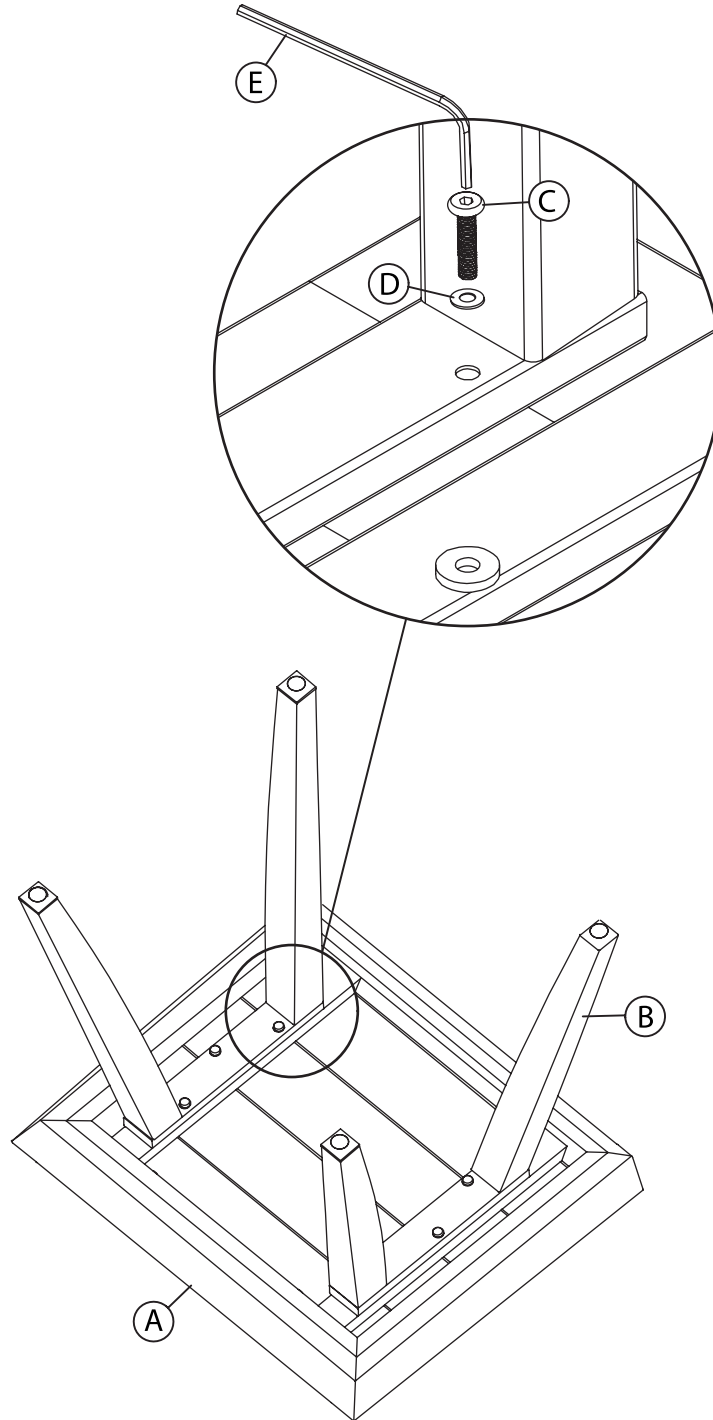

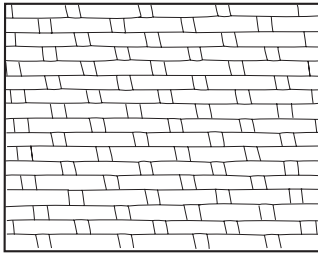
Step 1.

ATTACH LEGS TO TABLE TOP - Attach the table legs (B) to the table top (A) using washers (D), bolts (C), and allen wrench (E).



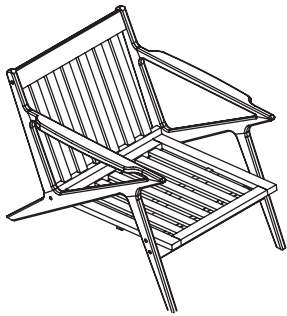
Care and Maintenance

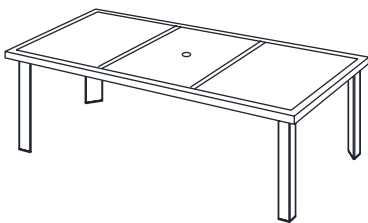
WICKER

Simply washing your wicker with a mild detergent and protecting it as much as possible by covering and or storing it when not in use for long periods of time is sufficient.



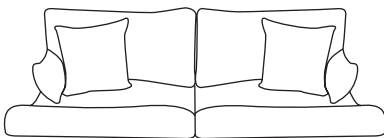
WOOD FRAMES

Make sure all surfaces are protected from heat and liquids. Wipe up spills immediately and do not place furniture next to a heat source such as radiators or fires. All timber surfaces may change color. Spray polishes are best to avoid as they contain silicones which may spoil the surface by building up overtime. Check bolts and screws regularly and tighten when necessary.



STONE TOPS/ TABLE TOPS

Spills should be wiped up quickly to avoid any staining on the surface. Regular cleaning with mild soap and water with a sponge or soft scrub brush is all that is required. Storing or covering your natural stone top when not in use for extended periods of time is recommended.



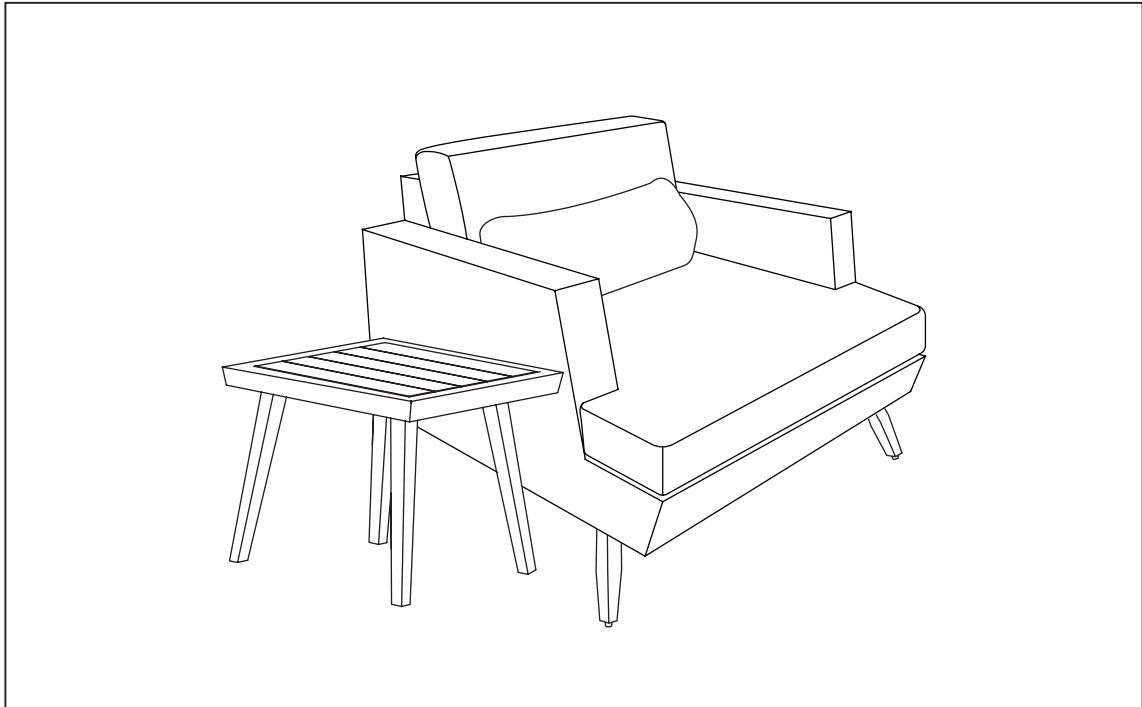
FABRICS

Wipe off spills with a cloth and water. RST Brands uses Sunbrella® fabrics designed to protect and last for several years. Sunbrella fabrics are treated with a proprietary water and stain repellent. 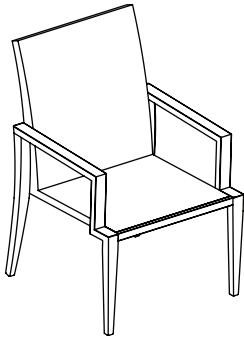
Cuidados y Mantenimiento

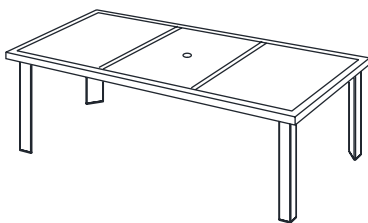
MIMBRE

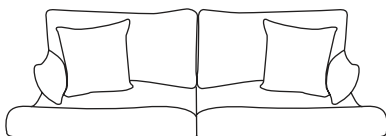
ESTRUCTURAS DE ALUMINIO

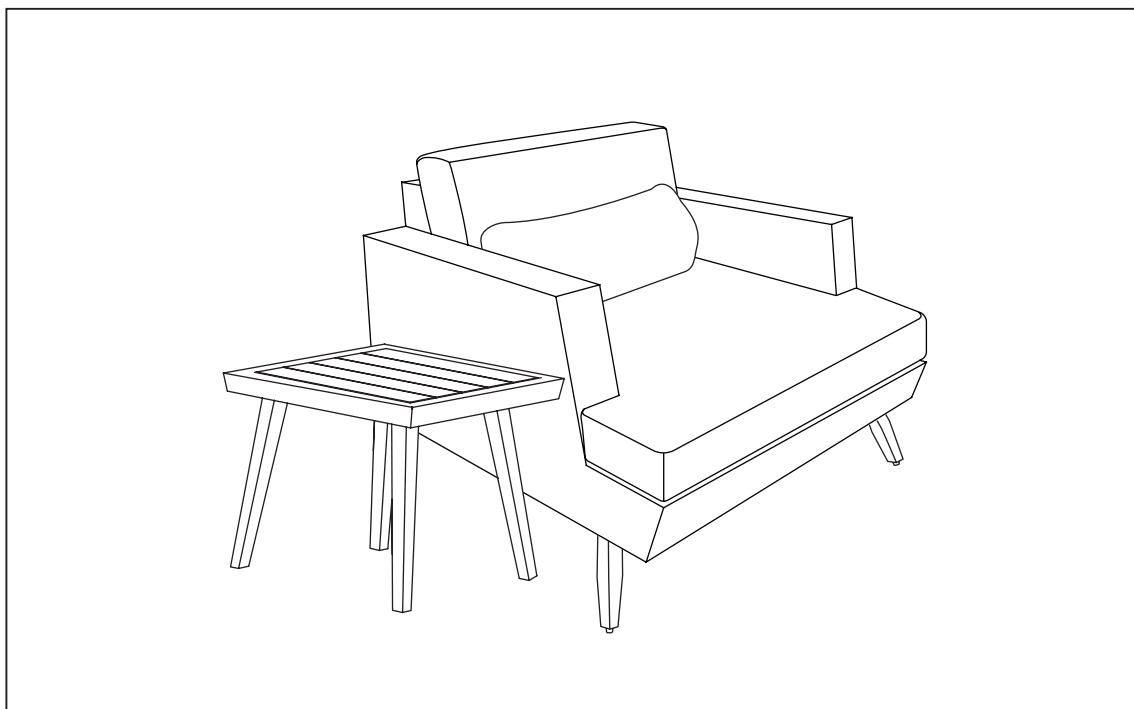
TEJIDOS

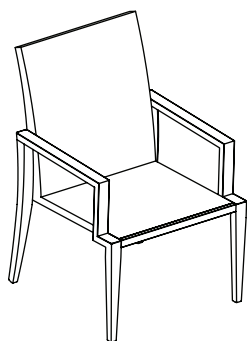
Soins et Entretien

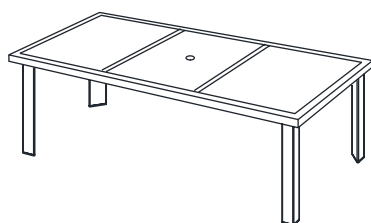
OSIER

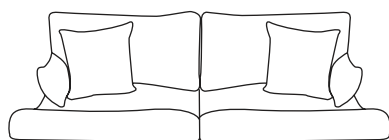
CADRES EN ALUMINIUM

SURFACES EN PIERRE / DESSUS DE TABLE

Ranger ou couvrir votre surface en pierres naturelles lorsqu'elle n'est pas utilisée pendant une durée étendue est recommandé.



TISSUS

Nettoyez les liquides renversés avec un tissu et de l'eau. RST Brands utilise Sunbrella®, conçu pour protéger et durer pendant plusieurs années.
